#### Brief Description of Institution

University of Warsaw, established in 1816, is Poland's biggest and best public university, recognized as one of the leading academic centres in Central-Eastern Europe.

University of Warsaw educates over 37'000 students. There are 25 Faculties and 30 other academic and research units. Students are offered over 260 programmes in humanities, social, exact and natural sciences, numerous interdisciplinary programmes, as well as 50 English-language programmes. Doctoral education is conducted in four multidisciplinary doctoral schools.

The University employs 8,100 people, including over 4,200 academic staff, whose scientific inquiry extends across more than 1,600 research topics. As one of Poland's leading research-intensive universities, UW is also a participant in the national "Excellence Initiative – Research University". UW is present in more than 20 countries in 5 continents and cooperates actively with over 1'000 institutions, including the 4EU+ European University Alliance.

This category may include Research Professors, Research Associate Professors, Research Assistant Professors, Research Fellows, Research Associates, Research Scientists, Postdoctoral Fellows, or equivalent academic positions. This category excludes PhD Students, Administrative Staff, Technical Staff, Laboratory technicians, Research Assistants, Librarians, Adjunct Professors, Visiting Scholars.

refers to the headcount number of full-time academic staff who do not hold the nationality of the country where the institution is located.

##### -D1.1.3 Of which was derived from research activities

refers to the income generated by the institution from research activities and related support activities, including governmental research grants, industry-sponsored research funding, revenues from research contracts, technical service fees, and other research-related income.

##### -D1.1.4 Of which was derived from donations and endowments

refers to funds received by the institution or institutional endowment from individuals, corporations, foundations, alumni organizations, or other external entities, with no restrictions or only limited restrictions on their use. This excludes revenues from investments of endowment funds.

#### -D1.1.5 Of which was derived from self-operating activities and investments

refers to the revenues generated by the institution through self-operating activities, service provision, investments (including investments of endowment funds), and the management or utilization of institutional assets. This category includes revenue from auxiliary services (housing, dining, and student health services) and intellectual property licensing (royalties, trademarks and patents), as well as returns on assets such as interest, dividends and rent. This excludes revenues generated by affiliated or majority-owned entities that operate as independent legal structures, such as the operating revenues of affiliated hospitals and the consolidated earnings of wholly-owned or majority-owned subsidiaries.
